Directions: Plot and draw a solid black line on the graph above indicating the normal growth efficiency in heart girth for the breed. Plot and draw a broken black line for the normal growth efficiency for the height at withers. (Obtain the normal efficiencies from the Dairy Heifer/Calf Growth Standards.) Measure your heifer/calf each month and, in a different color, plot and draw the actual growth of your heifer/calf in the solid and broken lines as indicated earlier. When you do this, you will be able to see the growth of your heifer/calf compared to the standard growth pattern. If your heifer/calf falls below the average, check for a problem and see if there is anything that you can do to improve her growth.
